

TUITION 2023-2024

INFORMATION SHEET

Our annual tuition of \$31,250 covers the cost of the regular school day program, including books and materials. Enrollment is secured with a signed contract and a <u>non-refundable</u> Enrollment Fee of \$3,125.

Tuition Payment Plan and Billing Information: Families agree to pay the remaining 50% of tuition by August 15 with the final 50% of tuition paid by January 15. All charges must be paid for by their due dates. A late fee of 1.5% for each month or portion thereof may be assessed and a \$30 charge will be assessed each time a check is not honored by the bank.

Sibling Discount: A 5% discount is applied to all subsequent siblings' tuition.

Tuition Responsibility

In accepting a place at Hudson Lab School, families agree to pay their student's tuition for the entire duration of the school year without deductions. There will be no refunds, tuition deductions or credits issued for a child's absence or withdrawal on account of illness, vacation or for any other reason during the school year including school closure due to any governmental order, force of nature or any other unforeseeable event outside of the control of Hudson Lab school. In the event of a school closure then HLS may provide remote distance learning to ensure continuity of education. There will be no reductions of tuition for such closure or modifications in the delivery of education and curriculum.

Tuition Assistance

There are a limited number of tuition assistance awards available. Please inquire if you are interested, and the school will follow up with you on next steps. The awards will be given on a first come first serve basis and are intended for highly qualified students of families committed to the Hudson Lab School approach to learning. While we will hold admissions places for admitted students until March 30th, we cannot hold tuition assistance awards. Families will have one week after a tuition assistance award decision is offered to accept. After that, we may offer the award to another qualified student on a first come, first serve basis.

Charge for Unfulfilled Volunteer Hours

One of the qualities that make HLS so wonderful is that we are a small, tight-knit community. We depend on the skills and talents of our parents in order to accomplish the school's mission. Each parent/guardian is asked to contribute a minimum of 12 hours of service per school year (24 hours total for a two-parent family). Your child will certainly benefit not only from your volunteering, but from the example you set. If these required hours are not met, parents/guardians agree to a payment of \$20 per hour unfulfilled, not to exceed \$480 for two parents or \$240 for a single parent payable by the last day of the school year. Possible service opportunities include being a Board Committee member or Parent Ambassador, providing gardening or carpentry work, helping to prepare classroom materials, coordinating special events, or alternatively providing suggestions for how you might best serve the community with your particular skills and talents.
